ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT - 1 CASE NO. 20-2-07084-0 SEA

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- The Court previously certified the Classes and appointed Karanbir Singh,
   Harpreet Singh, and Nasteho Omar as Class Representatives and the Terrell Marshall Law Group
   PLLC, and Leonard Law, PLLC, as Class Counsel.
- 4. The Court appoints Kroll Settlement Administration as the Class Administrator. As provided for in the Settlement Agreement, the Class Administrator shall disseminate notice to Class Members by mail, establish the Settlement Website and toll-free phone number, process and report on exclusion requests, establish and maintain an account for deposit of the Settlement Fund, mail Settlement Award checks to Class Members, and perform any additional duties that are called for by the Settlement Agreement or ordered by the Court.
- 5. IQ Data shall provide an updated class list to Class Counsel within 10 days of the date of this order for purposes of implementing the notice plan.
- 6. The Court approves the notice program outlined in the Settlement Agreement, including the Postcard Notices and Settlement Website attached as exhibits to the Declaration of Blythe H. Chandler. The notices provides all of the information Class Members need to evaluate and respond to the settlement, including the nature of the litigation, the general terms of the proposed settlement, their rights under the settlement, an explanation of how they can object to, or exclude themselves from the settlement and how to file a claim form to receive a payment from the FDCPA portion of the fund, the identity of Class Counsel and that Class Counsel will request attorneys' fees from the Settlement Fund, and the date and time of the Final Approval Hearing. The notice also direct Class Members to a website that will provide additional information about the settlement, as well as a toll-free number that Class Members can call with questions. Accordingly, the notice program complies with CR 23 and the requirements of due process.

- 7. The Court also approves the parties' plan for disseminating notice, which will ensure that Class Members receive "the best notice practicable under the circumstances." CR 23(c)(2). Issuance of notice substantially in the manner set forth in the Settlement Agreement satisfies the requirements of due process and applicable state and federal law and constitutes due and sufficient notice to all members of the Settlement Class.
- 8. Within 30 days of entry of this Order, the Class Administrator shall establish the Settlement Website and send notice to all Class Members in accordance with the notice plan described in Section VII.4 of the Settlement Agreement. The date the Settlement Administrator distributes notice is the "Notice Date."
- 9. FDCPA Class Members must submit claim forms either online or postmarked no later than 60 days from the Notice Date. The Court may exercise its discretion to approve otherwise valid but late filed claims received before the Final Approval Hearing.
- 10. Any Settlement Class Member may exclude himself or herself from the settlement by sending a written request to the Class Administrator through the Settlement Website or by mail postmarked no later than 60 days from the Notice Date. The exclusion request must be in writing and include the name and address of the individual requesting exclusion. Following final approval of the settlement and the occurrence of the Effective Date, each Settlement Class Member who does not submit a timely, valid request for exclusion shall be bound by all terms of the Settlement Agreement, including the release, and any final judgment entered by the Court in this case.
- 11. Any Class Member may object to the settlement by filing with the Court a written statement objecting to the settlement, along with any supporting documentation the Class Member wishes the Court to consider, no later than 60 days from the Notice Date. For their objection to be considered by the Court, the Class Member must not have excluded themself from the settlement.
- 12. IQ Data shall deposit the \$4,000,000 Settlement Fund amount with the Class Administrator no later than 45 days from the date of this order.

- 13. Class Counsel shall file their motion for an award of attorneys' fees, costs, and service award no later than 30 days from the Notice Date.
- 14. The Class Administrator shall provide the parties with a declaration of due diligence and proof of mailing, including information as to any inability to deliver notice because of invalid addresses, the number of claims, the number of requests for exclusion, and the number of objections, report on completion of the notice plan no later than 5 judicial days from the Opt-Out and Objection Deadline.
- 15. The Class Representatives shall file a motion for final approval of the settlement and response to any objections no later than 9 judicial days before the Final Approval Hearing.
- 16. A Final Approval Hearing shall be held before this Court (Judge Tanya L. Thorp) on March 1, 2023 at 8:30 a.m. via Zoom at meeting ID # 882 9217 8438 Passcode: 779783 or participants may attend in-person before the undersigned at W941, King County Superior Court, 516 3rd Avenue, Seattle, Washington, 98104. At the hearing, the Court will consider whether the Settlement is fair, reasonable, and adequate, and should be approved by the Court. The Court will also consider Class Counsel's motion for attorneys' fees and costs and for service award to the Class Representatives, and rule on any other matters that the Court deems appropriate.
- 17. Any interested person who has not excluded themselves from the Settlement Class may appear at the final approval hearing to address whether the proposed settlement should or should not be approved as fair, reasonable, and adequate. The Court will consider all properly submitted objections. Any Settlement Class Member who does not appear individually or through counsel and who does not challenge or comment upon the fairness and adequacy of the Settlement Agreement, Class Counsel's request for attorneys' fees and costs, or the Class Representatives' request for service awards shall waive and forfeit any and all rights to appear separately or object.

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**CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT - 4** 

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1	18. The Court retains jurisdiction over the Action and all matters arising out of or
2	connected with the proposed settlement. All deadlines in the current Case Scheduling Order are
3	hereby stricken, including the trial date, and all proceedings in the Action are hereby stayed other
4	than proceedings relating to the consideration of whether the settlement should be approved. The
5	Court reserves the right to adjourn or continue the date of the Final Approval Hearing without
6	further notice to Settlement Class Members and retains jurisdiction to consider all further
7	applications arising out of or connected with the settlement. After the Final Approval Hearing,
8	the Court may approve the settlement without further notice to Settlement Class Members.
9	19. If the Court does not enter the Final Approval Order, or if the Effective Date does
10	not occur for any reason, then the Action shall proceed as if the Settlement Agreement had not
11	been executed. In that event, the Parties shall meet and confer and present the Court with a
12	proposed revised case scheduling order.
